Such changes include not operating our own trade school this year. Instead, we will select a few teens and sponsor them in another trade school. Selecting a few students and standing with them over a long period of time will produce more fruit than we presently produce and will cut our operating costs in half.

Plans for Day Care Center Number 3 are underway. It will be established within our 3-story church

facility. Also, at the main facility we will have tutoring classes for 3rd grade children who, because of poor nutrition and/or low self esteem, are experiencing learning difficulties. We are able to make these changes by using the funds saved by not operating our own trade school, and double the impact of our outreach ministry to needy children.

Our wish for 2010 is to have lots of visitors. In fact, many of you who for various reasons, had to cancel your visit in 2009 owe us that visit this year!!
