### Born a Hazard?? (Part Two)

Some of you may remember Rosa, a very thin homeless girl who never left my side anytime I was on the streets. Rosa felt compelled to leave her home due to pressure placed on her from male clients who came to the bar her mother established in their home several years ago. This "pressure" began from the time she was nine years old. Finally, at age eleven, having no where to go, she began living on the streets. Sadly, she entered into the very lifestyle she was trying to avoid by leaving her home. By the time Rosa was fourteen she had begun to merchandise her body to obtain money to pay for an apartment. It was during that time she contacted AIDS. One month ago today, I preached Rosa's funeral. She was sixteen years old. During the last year she studied sewing at our trade school, we discovered that she was a teen with amazing undeveloped potential.

There are so many more girls like Rosa. It is for them that Nelly and I have been gearing up in prayer and planning to begin a transition home for teenaged girls in need.

### "Do it for Me." (Jesus)

Matthew 25 is divided into three parts: marriage and family life;

business opportunities; employment and career. These things were given to us of the Lord. However, in the latter part of the chapter the Lord asks something of us. It is a call for us to respond to HIM, to His need for us to feed Him, to visit Him, to give Him drink and food. "In as much as you did it to one of my little ones, you did it to me."

Forty five percent (45%) of the Honduran population is under fifteen years of age, and sixty-seven (67%) of them, more than half of the country, is considered a threat, or hazard, because they were born in poverty. The reality is that they are young people who simply suffer from the lack of opportunity! It is folks such as you and me who have the opportunity to respond to the cry of the Lord during our day. As we continue to give of our time, efforts, prayers, and finances to this ministry, we are endeavoring to bring about a positive difference in the lives of young people to whom Christ the Lord likens Himself.

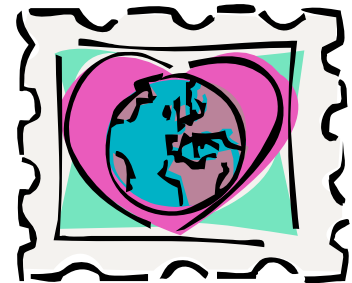
### Education: The Doorway to Opportunity
