### PROPER PRIOR PLANNING PRODUCES POSITIVE PROGRESS

Undoubtedly, we are experiencing times that the scriptures have informed us will come. While exciting to some degree, they are alarming. *More than ever, practicing the statement above will become a guideline for our lives and ministry here in Honduras.*

Our teachers and ministerial staff worked hard this year to provide the best Christian and basic education that we possibly could for each of the children and teens committed to our trust. Of the eighty-six children who attended our day care centers, twenty-seven will begin 2009 as kindergarteners. Another ten of them will be entering into first grade at a school of their parents' choice.

There were fourteen students enrolled in the electrical trade classes taught by B. J. Epperson this year. Many of them and others will continue to develop their skills in the coming year. Nineteen, of twenty-six young ladies will move into the workforce utilizing the skills they learned during their two years at our trade school program. Also, this ministry has assisted several of the teens confined to the detention centers with school uniforms, shoes, food, personal hy-



giene supplies, and with their graduation ceremony this year. We are confident many of these children and teenagers will be among the people of this country who will contribute positively to their families, churches, and communities.

### THE GREATEST GIFT

Everyone can plainly see that difficult times are ahead for our country and the world at large. The economy requires that each of us become much more cautious regarding how we invest and spend our money. However, let us not lose sight of our values and those things that are in the eyes of the Lord: that we seek first His kingdom and righteousness.
